Lake County Motorcycle Association Toy Run Makes Record Donation

On Thursday, December 11, 2008, the Lake County United Motorcyclist Association held the wrap-up meeting for the 5th Annual Toy Run that was held on December 6, 2008. The proceeds of the toy run are donated to The Salvation Army and the Lake/Sumter Foster Parent Association.

According to Gregg Case (who chaired the event), "We can be very pleased with the results of this year's toy run and know that we are able to put the money in the hands of those who will be "doing the most good" with it." Case went on to add, "I have some impressive results to share and wanted to let you know just what the association members' hard work actually produced. "Both the Lake County Salvation Army and the Lake County Foster Parents Association received \$8,250.00 for a total net of \$16,500.00 for 2008. Everyone deserves a round applause! That is \$250.00 over last year's distributions to each group." Case noted, "There were 403 official riders and 300 motorcycles. Though our numbers were lower due to the weather, we produced more money and a truck full of the highest quality toys we've had to date. The move to Wal-Mart was a bone fide success."

Case continued, "Based on the current figures for participation, as well as the amount of money and toys collected, I believe that our annual event is the largest, best and most productive in this county! Our members can be very proud to be a part of this fine group of generous, compassionate people who have now collected nearly \$60,000 in cash plus truckloads of toys for two wonderful organizations since our first event in 2004."

Captain Sandra Bagley, Corps officer for The Salvation Army said "I look forward to this every year. It is a pleasure to work with so many hard working and dedicated people who truly put the needs of our needy children and families at the top of their priorities. It is a long planning process, but I know that we are going to have toys for the kids and the funds to help needy families. This year is particularly meaningful, due to

Ken's & my retirement in January. I will miss all the fun I have of shopping for the toys and getting to ride on the motorcycles and the great fellowship we share. May God bless them all, they are certainly a blessing to all of us.

Gregg Case is already looking forward to May of 2009, when they we will start the planning process for the next toy run.
